

Significant Findings



- Internet Addiction recognized in the 90s and continues to be a global problem. (Now an ICD code for gaming disorder)
- Cyberbullying changes the psyche of both victims and perpetrators
- Online Dating scams, identity theft, finding friends
- Children and screens heated debates and high emotions on both sides
- **Deep Fakes** improve therapy/training, digital twinning, effects of disinformation, confusion between IRL and Virtual
- Virtual Worlds VR/AR/XR, online shared worlds, The Metaverse
